3 Proposal for Festival Hall construction at Utsav ground

KL placed the issue to the committee for consultation among members. KL proposed for a permanent hanger at Utasv ground.

Followings are the points as highlighted by the committee members:

- Need to ascertain the design and infrastructural cost element.
- Construction of a permanent hanger would lead to an annual cost reduction in the range of 20-25% of actual pandal cost.
- It is possible T4 residents might object to the same as it would obstruct their open view.
- It is to be examined whether KMC approval needs to be taken or not?
- Any fire hazard or firefighting restriction will be compromised or not?
- Having a permanent hanger at Utasv ground will give greater scope for revenue generation beyond Utsav as we could then hold other community activities regularly at the site
- It would lead to convenience of holding other games and activities in the covered area.

All committee members agreed that this is a good proposal for the benefit of residents. However, earlier this proposal was rejected by BNRI on the ground that firefighting equipment movement will be restricted. Members suggested for retractable shed.

International standard cricket training ground

It was pointed out that BNRI had earlier agreed to sponsor 25 lakhs for developing this kind of infrastructure opposite the Tower 5 ground. But same could not be materialized due to objection raised by residents of Tower 5.

P, S and Sports committees BNRI,UFM

It is now proposed to develop a similar kind of infrastructure in the Central Lawn but in a slightly smaller scale by laying all weather synthetic turf with high nets all around. Training program can be restricted to 3-4 months in a year. During that period football will be restricted.

However, our Central Lawn is more like a leisure ground over the basement for the residents to come and enjoy the open space. It was never designed for rough use and has its limitations. It is not a regular field but more of a roof top Lawn over the basement Car Park. The Lawn is built with 8 inches of soil over the basement. Any damage to the ground can lead to permanent damage to the protective shield below the 8" of soil resulting in severe damage and weakening the Basement Roof. The damage to the basement roof would lead to water leaking from the grounds into the basement car park area. Above cricket training proposal can only be considered after relaying/repair/ restoration of Central Lawn. BNRI will be asked to initiate this process of relaying/repair/ restoration work.
